# Taxiway A Rehab 60% Plans & Phasing Review

Russ Holliday with Avcon addressed the Board and presented them with the Taxiway Alpha Rehab update. Holliday explained the general phasing notes and the addition of the closing of the runway. Holliday briefly discussed the phasing summary. Cobb asked Holliday if the runway would be closed only during phase 1. Holliday replied that was correct. Holliday discussed the new vault. Cobb asked about a generator. Holliday stated a generator was not included in the grant request. Cobb asked Holliday if he could ask FAA if a generator could be added to the grant. Holliday stated he would ask FAA if funding would be available. Johnson recommended getting the cost of a transfer switch. Further discussion was had on powering the runway during an outage. Cobb suggested to Holliday to ask about the generator. Holliday replied he would and if it was not possible it could be added to the CIP for next year. Gillespie asked if LED lighting was going to be used. Holliday stated he would ask. Cobb advised Holliday to make sure the lighting was going to reflect LED lighting for the contractor. Holliday recapped the request from the Board: 1. Ask FAA about eligibility for funding of a generator and/or transfer switch 2. If LED lighting was going to be used. Holliday stated FAA had advanced the deadline up a month and now the project was behind schedule. Holliday stated bids would go out in April. Cobb and the Board thanked Holliday for all of his work on the project.
