CE Officer Bergens presented the case to Special Magistrate Dawson. Bergens stated there was an untagged vehicle on the property and had been in contact with Castillo and informed her that she needed to tag the vehicle. Bergens noted she gave additional time for Castillo to comply and time had expired. Castillo stated she would get the vehicle tagged but needed a little longer. Discussion was had on tagging the vehicle or moving it to a property outside the City. Special Magistrate Dawson gave until October 31, 2020 to become compliant and if not in compliance a fine of \$50 a day shall be assessed until brought into compliance.

CE Officer Bergens stated the case was compliant. Special Magistrate Dawson noted violations did exist but had been remedied.
