

The Wauchula Historic Preservation Board met Monday, February 22, 2021 at 5:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Chair Tanya Royal, William Boynton, Dr. Sylvia Collins, and Linda Burnett.

Board Members Jennifer Clark, Cynthia Paxton, Raafat Zakhary and were absent.

Also present were Community Development Coordinator Kyle Long and City Clerk Holly Smith.

Royal called the meeting to order at 5:00p.m.

Certificate of Appropriateness – 225 W. Main Street (Signage)

Royal stated the certificate of appropriateness was from Monograms on Main and asked for a motion to begin discussion. Collins motioned to approve the certificate of appropriateness, seconded by Boynton. Boynton asked how the sign would be affixed to the building and what the material of the sign was. Terri noted the material of the sign was aluminum and it would be drilled into the brick. Terri noted they had only received one bid and it was from Mulberry. Burnett asked if the sign complied with the color pallet. Long stated the color pallet was intended mainly for the paint colors and not necessarily sign colors. Long stated he did not have any concerns. Boynton made suggestions on how the sign should be affixed to the building in order to preserve the brick.

With no further discussion, Royal called for all in favor, all responded aye. For those opposed like sign, no response. Motion carried.

Certificate of Appropriateness – 109 W. Main Street (Signage)

Royal stated the certificate of appropriateness was from Ken Kilgore at 109 W. Main Street. Royal asked for a motion to begin discussion. Boynton motioned to approve the certificate of appropriateness, seconded by Burnett. Minor discussion was had on the certificate of appropriateness. Long stated the sign was on the window. With no further discussion, Royal called for all in favor, all responded aye. For those opposed like sign, no response. Motion carried.
