The Wauchula Planning and Zoning Board met on Monday, July 18, 2016 at 5:30 p.m.

The following members were present: Vice-Chairman Garry Phillips, Chairwoman Donna Steffens, Gerald Waldron, Wayne Johnson and Ray Graham.

Also present were Community Development Coordinator Kyle Long and Deputy City Clerk Victoria Thompson.

Chairwoman Steffens called the meeting to order

Approval of Minutes – May 16, 2016

Phillips motioned to approve the minutes of May 16th as presented, seconded by Graham. Deputy City Clerk Thompson polled the Board, all were in favor.

Rezone Request – Juan Curci – 206 N 8th Avenue:

Dr. Palmer's old office and the building facing Palmetto Street will remain P-1, Professional / Office space. The building behind is what is being requested to be rezoned and will be upgraded to apartments. Mr. Lambert clarified the property location.

Architectural Standards and Aesthetics
